This letter is a follow up to our meeting on November 17, 2005 where you discussed the NCCU 2002 Campus Master Plan update. At that meeting a representative of the City of Durham's economic development consultant, RKG Associates, wrote down comments made in that meeting and gave this list to a representative from NCCU. This list was a list of items or potential conflicts between NCCU and the Fayetteville Street Corridor community. At that meeting, you pledged that a committee of NCCU representatives would meet with neighborhood representatives to begin the discussion on the issues identified that night. To date, we have not heard from anyone from NCCU regarding a meeting nor have we received a copy of the list that the consultant generated.
